To whom it may concern:

Six medical workers, one Palestinian medical intern and five Bulgarian nurses, in Benghazi, Libya have been charged with conspiring to deliberately infect over 400 children with HIV. It caused an epidemic at the El-Fatih Children's Hospital in Benghazi. Swept up in the panic and pandemonium, the six medical workers were sentenced to death. Their case was remanded by Libya's highest court only to be sentence to death again. Although many experts and organizations have come forward on behalf of the medics, none have been successful.

Our office is cooperating with the Bulgarian government and the medic's families to repeal the court's verdict on grounds of solid new evidence supporting the medical worker's innocence. We have documented and reported extensively on court proceedings in our magazine to bring awareness. However, because of our lack of knowledge about biology, we do not have a cohesive and complete case to present to the court.

Therefore, we would like you to create a 10min. documentary supporting the Bulgarian medic's innocence by using your knowledge of biology. It should be filmed and edited in a professional manner because the winning documentary will be posted on our website. It's important let you know before that a lot of our readers may not be familiar with HIV. In order for your documentary to connect with audiences, you should articulate the nature of viruses, mutations and natural selection by writing an article for each topic beforehand.
